

ABSTRAK

Mahasiswa tingkat akhir program studi sejarah peradaban Islam bimbang dalam menentukan karir. Mereka cemas untuk bertahan pada bidang pilihan tersebut. Mereka bimbang untuk memilih bekerja dimana setelah lulus kuliah, belum memiliki bayangan akan pekerjaan, kurang maksimal dalam menyelesaikan studi sampai selesai, dan mereka belum melakukan eksplorasi karir pada area-area bidang sesuai yang mereka pelajari. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui hubungan *career indecision* dengan komitmen pilihan karir pada mahasiswa tingkat akhir program studi sejarah peradaban Islam di UIN Sunan Gunung Djati Bandung. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode kuantitatif korelasional. Subjek dalam penelitian ini berjumlah 110 mahasiswa. Pada penelitian ini, *career indecision* diukur menggunakan skala *career indecision* yang disusun berdasarkan teori *career indecision* dari Osipow sedangkan alat ukur komitmen pilihan karir disusun berdasarkan teori dari Blustein. Untuk menganalisis data, peneliti menggunakan teknik *product moment*. Hasil penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa terdapat hubungan antara *career indecision* dengan komitmen pilihan karir dengan nilai sig. (1-tailed) = -0.214 dan r= 0.012 Hal ini menunjukkan H_0 ditolak dan H_1 diterima artinya terdapat hubungan signifikan yang negatif antara *career indecision* dengan komitmen pilihan karir. Semakin tinggi *career indecision* mahasiswa tingkat akhir program studi sejarah peradaban Islam di UIN Sunan Gunung Djati Bandung maka semakin rendah komitmen pilihan karirnya.

ABSTRACT

Final year students of the history of Islamic civilization study program are confused about choosing a career. They are anxious to stay in their chosen field. They are confused about choosing a job after graduating from college, they don't have an idea of a job, they are less than optimal in completing their studies to completion, and they haven't explored careers in the areas they studied. This research aims to determine the relationship between career decision and career choice commitment in final year students of the history of Islamic civilization study program at UIN Sunan Gunung Djati Bandung. This study uses a correlational quantitative method. The subjects in this research were 110 students. In this research, career indecision was measured using a career indecision scale which was prepared based on Osipow's career indecision theory, while the career choice commitment measuring tool was prepared based on Blustein's theory. To analyze the data, researchers used the product moment technique. The results of this research show that there is a relationship between career decision and commitment to career choice with a sig value. (1-tailed) = -0.214 and r= 0.012. This shows that H0 is rejected and H1 is accepted, meaning that there is a significant negative relationship between career decision and career choice commitment. The higher the career decision of students in the final year of the history of Islamic civilization study program at UIN Sunan Gunung Djati Bandung, the lower the commitment to their career choice.
